Worshipping in church after July 19th:

After talking through the different options with me and the Church Wardens, and in response to the lifting of government covid restrictions on 19th July, Rachel shared the following update with the congregation on 18th July:

We will be taking a 'gentle steps' approach as follows:

- We no longer need to sit socially distanced from one another. If you would, however, like to have space around you, there will be cards available to put on the seats next to you to keep those spaces free.
- We ask you to continue wearing face masks inside the church until these changes are reviewed after Rachel's return from holiday.
- We will keep sharing the peace from a distance, for the time being.
- Communion will continue to be served in one kind for now (no common cup).
- We can sing! Please do keep your face masks on though while singing.
- We can start having refreshments again! Initially we will be serving these outside the building.

And above all - do keep being gentle and considerate with each other. You never know who is more at risk or a little more worried about risks of covid. Many thanks for your patience and the many ways you have served faithfully and shown so much flexibility over the last 15+ months! **Kate**


